110	Pursuant to the Ngati Tama Claims Settlement Act 2003, section 10 (2), the meaning of Ngati Tama includes individuals who can relate with the
111	"Ngati Tama Area of Interest," rather than the Ngati Tama rohe - while Ngati Tama consider the area of interest and the rohe to be the same area
112	the words "area of interest" satisfied the parties at that time.
113	Accordingly, as the 1882 Mohakatino - Paraninihi Native Land Court Decision, awarded all land north of the confiscation line to Ngati Maniapoto,
114	also set 500 acres for Te Kaeaea (Taringakuri)
